Learning about Transformational Change in International Climate Finance Workshop, 21 June 2019, Bonn, GER

Abstract

The aim of the workshop is to share and discuss work by international climate finance institutions on transformational change in support of climate change prevention and preparedness. During the workshop, [CIF](#), [GCF](#), [NAMA Facility](#), [BEIS](#) and [GEF](#) (tbc) will share their approaches to understanding and assessing transformational change with the aim to foster joint understanding and further collaboration not only among themselves, but among a broad array of stakeholders including funders, policy makers, project implementors and think tanks. The longer-term objective is to support joint learning and improve the basis for future decision making, including the selection, support, design and evaluation of climate actions to drive transformational change.

The workshop will consist of four parts:

- i) An opening that informs participants about transformational change context, status and goals through presentations from different funders;
- ii) A World Café to encourage exchange between the funding organizations and workshop participants and discuss more details on the conceptual frameworks and implementation of transformational climate actions;
- iii) A co-working session to share lessons, integrate experiences and offer ways to improve the concepts and actions of funders; and
- iv) A plenary session to share results from the parallel co-working sessions and share ideas for future collaboration on transformational change in the context of climate finance.
